

Vaping in Schools - HB 58

This week the House passed HB 58 Electronic Cigarettes in Schools Amendments (70-0-5) which addresses student use of alcohol, tobacco, and electronic cigarette products through education, prevention, and discipline programs. Today, over 12% of Utah's youth actively vape. We are working to combat this crisis and keep our kids safe and healthy.



My Legislation-HB 219

HB-219 Mental Health Amendments

This bill aids in the treatment of those persons with serious mental health issues. Previously there was a limit on the number of beds that an institute could have for the treatment of mental health, this bill seeks to change that.

This bill passed the House on February 20th.
